By Car

Parking onsite is only available for Squadron Cadet Forces Adult Volunteers. Cadets must be dropped off and collected promptly.

Please ensure that you are not dropped off or collected outside the Squadron Gates or the surrounding area which must be kept **CLEAR AT ALL TIMES**. This is the only emergency access to the Squadron is and egress point to our Fire Assembly Point. Staff require this area to unlock the premises and to conduct a full security sweep of the site, prior to you accessing the building.

As the Squadron is located in a highly residential area, please be mindful of local residents. Those in Eastcroft House are particularly sensitive, as the Squadron often receives numerous complaints from residents that parents are parking in resident bays. The Squadron strongly advises not to park in Eastcroft House, and to use it only for prompt drop offs and pick-ups only - please be aware that there are double yellow lines on the site.

There are other local sites near Northolt Road, and Grange Road which can be used for drop offs and pick-ups and for parking should your parent/guardian/carer need to visit us if you are scheduled to finish later.

Do not park in the areas highlighted in Red by the Squadron HQ as this is used for Emergency access.
